Re: Cabinet Decision no 2241 taken on Friday 23rd January 2013

Authorising Officers to enter into a local burden sharing scheme with neighbouring crematoria, the cost of this scheme being met by the addition of an extra fee on each cremation to be agreed with the Portfolio Holder for Environment and Coast Protection

The above Cabinet decision was taken having duly considered the options of either entering the national burden sharing scheme for not installing mercury abatement equipment by the due date of 31<sup>st</sup> December 2012 or to enter a locally administered scheme.

Quotations have been sought for a local burden sharing scheme which can operate from the 1<sup>st</sup> January at a cost of either £24 or £25 per cremation, depending upon which crematorium has abated cremations available to trade, and as indicated in the above decision it was agreed that an extra fee would be applied to each cremation to cover this cost.

Whilst the requirement to pay into a local burden sharing scheme for 50% of cremations commenced as from the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2013 the above decision being taken until after that date and therefore it has not been able to recover the expenditure from that point in time.

Accordingly, under the powers delegated to me in consultation with you, I intend to add £12.50 to each cremation, as from the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2013, index linked annually as per the local agreement, and fund the estimated £4,500 due from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2013 from existing revenue budgets.

I therefore seek your concurrence with the foregoing, and would be pleased if you could sign and return the attached pro-forma at your earliest convenience.
